### Brief review of main current professional and research interests

She conducted research activities at Catholic University, Dep. of Statistical Sciences, as demographer for the National Inter-Universities research projects (PRIN). In 2006 she started periodic collaborations with external foundations, public administration, centres for sociological and criminological research and other university departments. Her main interests are research and teaching in applied methodological tools and collecting macro data for the quantitative analysis of social and demographic behaviours. More specific domains of interest are: ageing; micro-macro analysis of socio-demographic behaviours; multilevel models; business demography; social network analysis; social integration of second generations of immigrants; analysis of co-authorships in demographic science.
