

Elisabetta Barbi is Professor of Demography at Sapienza University of Rome (Italy), where she teaches “Demography”, “Demographic Models”, and “International Demography”. After obtaining her PhD in Demography from Florence University (Italy), she worked as Research Scientist at the Max Planck Institute for Demographic Research in Rostock (Germany), and as Associate Professor of Demography at Messina University (Italy) and at Sapienza University of Rome. Elisabetta Barbi is the coordinator of the curriculum of Demography within the PhD program of Statistical Sciences at Sapienza University and a member of the Board of the European Doctoral School of Demography. She is the Editor-in-Chief of the scientific journal *Genus* (Springer). Her research focuses on elderly mortality, selective survival, and longevity.
