Editorial Office checks all submitted content through **CrossRef Similarity Check software**. It generates a **similarity report**, highlighting the **percentage of** overlap between the uploaded article and the **published material**. Any instance of content overlap is further scrutinized for suspected plagiarism according to the publisher's Editorial Policies. Journal Kemija u industriji allows an overall similarity of 20% for a manuscript to be considered for publication.

Sustainability - Advertising


- Companies or corporations can be co-publisher of the journal for an annual fee of 2000 Euro. In return, they are provided pages for publishing their articles, technological and other news, calendar of events, etc.
- **Sponsorships** are indicated separately in each issue of the journal, as well as other KUI editions. Sponsor companies are provided 10 copies of each issue, and/or 5 copies of other editions free of charge.
- For an annual fee of 1000 Euro, the sponsor company is provided pages for publishing professional and technical information, as well as 6 copies of each issue free of charge.

Instructions to authors

Reviewing

The papers assigned to the afore-mentioned categories are subject to review by two anonymous reviewers. A paper will be accepted for publication only if it is positively evaluated, about which the Editorial Board shall notify the author. The reviewers are selected among experts in the field discussed in the paper to be published. Authors may recommend reviewers, however the Editorial Board is not required to accept their recommendation.

Language and style

Principally, papers are published in Croatian or English. Authors of scientific and professional papers are required to submit the summary, title and subtitles both in Croatian and English. The writing should be ear, concise, free of grammatical or typing errors, and written in third person (impersonal). The paper should be written in the assumption that the reader is familiar with the field being discussed.



Instructions to authors

Title

The title should reflect clearly and concisely the content of the paper, and preferably should not consist of more than 12 words. Non-standard acronyms, symbols and formulas should be avoided.

Scope

Manuscripts (together with the figures and images) should not exceed 10–15 typed pages (two images roughly correspond to one page). Longer articles will be accepted only if justified by their content and quality. **Author responsibility**

Authors are fully responsible for the contents of their paper. The Editorial Board will presume that authors have been granted permission to reproduce previously published material, or that the publication of their work complies with the rules of their affiliated companies or institutions
